He attended Pacific Lutheran University in Tacoma, WA, where he earned a Bachelor of Music in Vocal Performance. Following graduation, he was accepted into the Tacoma Opera Young Artist Program, and served a year-long music internship with the Tacoma Youth Chorus and Charles Wright Academy. This conducting experience led him to pursue a Master of Music in Choral Conducting at Butler University in Indianapolis, Indiana. While there, he served as Conducting Fellow for the Indianapolis Symphonic Choir and Assistant Conductor of the Butler Chorale.

In May 2014, upon completion of his degree, he taught music in Arlington County, Virginia and served as director of the Bel Canto ensemble with the Children's Chorus of Washington. In 2014 he auditioned for The United States Army Band "Pershing's Own" and won his current seat as a member of The U.S. Army Voices.
